

KERRY AIRPORT ANNOUNCE NEW DIRECT FLIGHT TO GRENOBLE FRANCE WITH RYANAIR

Commencing Saturday 20th of December, this weekly flight brings the wonder and excitement of the Alpine Ski Slopes within easy and affordable access to the people of Kerry and beyond

Today Kerry Airport officially announced that Ryanair will operate a scheduled weekly service direct to Grenoble, Lyon, France. The **service will commence on the 20th of December** and offers convenient Saturday day time flights - departing Kerry Airport at 15.35 and arriving in Grenoble at 18.45* and returning from Grenoble at 19.15 back into Kerry Airport at 20.25*. Located at Saint-Etienne de Saint Geoirs, Grenoble/Lyon Airport is the gateway to the spectacular Rhone-Alps region. Located 50 minutes away by car from Lyon (the capital) and 30 minutes from Grenoble, Grenoble/Lyon Airport is the perfect entry point into the Rhone-Alps. Thanks to this region's outstanding natural, historical and cultural assets, the Rhone-Alps area of France has established an international reputation as a prime tourist destination. The mountains are one of the region's main attractions for winter sports - and the region has almost 200 ski resorts (the largest proportion of France's skiing centres) all within 2 hours drive time from Grenoble / Lyon Airport. Kerry Airport currently has three daily direct flights to Dublin; two daily flights to London Stansted; three times' weekly flights to London Luton; five times' weekly flights direct to Manchester and a daily flight to Frankfurt Hahn. The Airport also offers weekly Summer sun charter series direct to Majorca with Falcon / JWT. Kerry Airport won the prestigious Irish Airport of the Year in 2005 from the CCI and was recently declared as the first Heartsafe Airport in Ireland by the Irish Heart Foundation.

Superb access by car, bus, train and taxi

By car

A48 exit Rives / Saint Geoirs / Airport / Lyon 80km, 50 minutes / Grenoble 40km, 30 minutes

By bus

(low fare services to Grenoble, Lyon and ski resorts from 4 EUR one-way)
Low fare scheduled bus services connect Grenoble/Lyon airport with the Grenoble city
centre (train and bus station) and Lyon city centre for each Blu-Express flights.

By train

Major Ski resorts within easy access of Grenoble Lyon Airport

4 major ski regions are within an easy reach: Isère, Savoie, Haute-Savoie and Hautes-Alpes. In Isère your will find Les Deux Alpes (77 kms from Grenoble), a magnificent ski resort catering for skiers of all abilities. Also in this region is L'Alpe d'Huez, a modern, purpose-built resort close to Grenoble (77 kms). The ski area here stretches over 230 sq kms, has 84 lifts, and caters for all levels. It has some superb off-piste facilities available for the more adventurous and experienced skiers. Savoie hosts worldwide famous resorts such as Tignes, Val d'Isère, La Plagne, les Arcs, Val Thorens and Méribel (all under 160 kms from Grenoble), and the Haute-Savoie offers great resorts such as Les Gets, Morzine, and Chamonix.
